1. This order shall dispose of three petitions i.e. CRM-M-11678-2025, CRM-M-13745-2025 & CRM-M-15901-2025, as the same have emanated out of the same occurrence.

2. Prayer in the petition, filed under Section 482 of BNSS, 2023, is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners, who have been booked for having committed the offences punishable under Sections 110, 115, 118(1) (2), 190, 191(2) and 191(3) of BNS, 2023, in a case arising out of FIR No. 12, dated 11.01.2025, registered at Police Station Civil Lines Hisar, District Hisar.

3. In the anticipatory bail petition i.e. CRM-M-11678-2025, on 03.03.2025 following order was passed:-

“1. Prayer in this petition, filed under Section 482 of BNSS, 2023, is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner, who has been booked for having committed the offences punishable under Sections 110, 115, 118(1) (2), 190, 191(2) and 191(3) of BNS, 2023, in a case arising out of FIR No. 12, dated 11.01.2025, registered at Police Station Civil Lines Hisar, District Hisar.

2. Notice of motion.

3. On advance notice, learned State counsel puts in appearance on behalf of the respondent – State, and seeks some time to file status report in the matter.

4. Adjourned to 01.04.2025.

5. In the meanwhile, arrest of the petitioner shall remain stayed.”

4. In the anticipatory bail petition i.e. CRM-M-13745-2025, on 20.03.2025, following order was passed:-

“1. Prayer in the present petition under Section 482 of BNSS, 2023 (earlier



Section 438 Cr.P.C.) is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.12 dated 11.01.2025, under Sections 110, 115, 118(1)(2), 190, 191(2) and 191(3) of BNS, 2023, registered at Police Station Civil Lines Hisar, Haryana.

2. Status report dated 19.03.2025, in the shape of affidavit of Sunil Kumar, HPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Women Safety, Hisar, has been filed on behalf of respondent – State of Haryana and the same is taken on record.

3. At the very outset, counsel for the petitioner refers to order dated 03.03.2025 passed in CRM-M-11678-2025 (Annexure P-3).

4. Adjourned to 01.04.2025.

5. In the meanwhile, arrest of the petitioner shall remain stayed.

6. It is made clear that issue of joining investigation would be examined on the next date.

7. To be heard along with CRM-M-11678-2025 on 01.04.2025”

5. In the anticipatory bail petition i.e. CRM-M-15901-2025, on 24.03.2025, following order was passed:-

“1. Prayer in this petition, filed under Section 482 of the BNSS, 2023 (earlier Section 438 Cr.P.C.), is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner, who has been booked in a criminal case arising out of First Information Report, as detailed hereunder:-

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner, inter alia, contends that from the CCTV footage, learned Sessions Judge has observed that the petitioner was armed with gandasi and was present at the spot.



3. *Notice of motion.*

On advance notice, Mr. Kanwar Sanjiv Kumar, AAG, Haryana, puts an appearance on behalf of the respondent/State, and Mr. Shubham Kaushik, Advocate, puts in appearance on behalf of the complainant.

4. *Since, anticipatory bail petition i.e. CRM-M-11678-2025 of the co-accused, namely, Ankit is fixed for 01.04.2025, adjourned to 01.04.2025.*

To be heard along with CRM-M-11678-2025.

5. *Interim order, in the same terms, as indicated in CRM-M-11678-2025.*

However, issue of joining of investigation of the petitioner, would be considered on the next date of hearing.”

6. As FIR No.12 dated 11.01.2025, under Sections 110, 115, 118(1)(2), 190, 191(2) and 191(3) of BNS, 2023, registered at Police Station Civil Lines Hisar, Haryana and all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom have already been quashed by separate order of even date passed in CRM-M-24615-2025, the present anticipatory bail petitions i.e. CRM-M-11678-2025, CRM-M-13745-2025 & CRM-M-15901-2025 have become infructuous.

7. All the three petitions are disposed of, as having been rendered infructuous.

8. A photocopy of this order be placed on the files of the connected cases.
