1. Prayer in the present petition is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.65 dated 01.05.2025, under Section 21(b)/29 of NDPS Act registered at Police Station Cantt. Bathinda.
2. Vide order dated 06.06.2025, while granting interim protection, the petitioner was directed to join investigation.
3. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that pursuant to order dated 06.06.2025, petitioner has joined the investigation and as such his interim bail may be made absolute.
4. Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Rajpal Singh, affirmed the fact that the petitioner has joined the investigation and he is no more required for further investigation.
