1. The petitioner through instant petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India is seeking setting aside of order dated 30.12.2024 (Annexure P-2) whereby he has been transferred from District Jalandhar Rural to District Police Commissionerate Ludhiana.

2. The petitioner claims that he has been transferred on account of FIR No. 232 dated 04.09.2021 under Section 384 of IPC and Section 7 of Prevention of Corruption Act, 1988 registered at Police Station Phillaur, District Jalandhar Rural against him. Transfer is punitive in nature. He is on the verge of retirement.

3. Mr. Aman Dhir, DAG, Punjab who on advance notice is present in Court submits that this Court vide judgment dated 15.03.2024 passed in bunch of petitions including *Civil Writ Petition No.4736 of 2024* titled as '*Amandeep Singh Vs. State of Punjab and another*' has declined claim of similarly situated employees.

4. The petitioner is not claiming that criminal proceedings stand instituted against him whereas he is claiming that mere FIR has been registered against him, thus, his case is not covered by Rule 14.15 (5) of Punjab Police Rules, 1934. The case of petitioner is squarely covered by afore-cited judgment of this Court.

5. Dismissed.
