The petition has been filed seeking a writ of *mandamus* directing the respondents to release the Leave Encashment and Leave Travelling Concession (L.T.C.) to the petitioner, pending on account of her deceased husband's retirement, alongwith interest at the rate of twenty four percent per annum.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that grievance raised herein is pending for appropriate decision before respondents. At this stage, the petitioner will be satisfied in case respondent no.2 is directed to decide her representation, dated 15.03.2024, Annexure P-7, in a specified period.
