Registry has put up this matter for ensuring compliance of the order passed by this Court on 18.12.2024, by which the Civil Writ Petition No 8850-2022 had been disposed of with certain directions for removal of encroachment.

2. After the respondents exhausted the remedy before the Apex Court which upheld the order of this Court dated 18.12.2024 by mainly granting further time of four weeks to encroachers to avail remedy under the law, it is informed by three status reports dated 21.03.2025, 08.04.2025 and 07.05.2025 that encroachments, which had not been protected by the judicial orders, have already been removed but in respect of certain encroachments, the matter is *subjudice* in Letters Patent Appeal No. 609-2025, '*Harbans Singh and others vs. State of Punjab and others*' in which the Co-ordinate Bench of this Court has directed maintenance status quo.

3. In view of aforesaid, it is obvious that compliance has been made in respect of all encroachments except one which is *sub judice*.

4. In view of the above, this case be consigned to the record room.
