SMT. KAMLESH DEVI AND OTHERS VS. DAG LAL MAHTO AND OTHERS

Vide order dated 20.02.2025 on the basis of the statement made by learned counsel for the appellants a proposal was made for enhancing compensation by Rs.8,19,000/- over and above the amount already granted by the MACT concerned. Today, learned counsel for the Insurance Companies has stated that the Insurance Companies have agreed to enhance the compensation only by Rs.7,50,000/- and not by Rs.8,19,000/- and have signed to that effect. Learned counsel for the appellants has agreed to this counter offer of the Insurance Company.

We dispose of this case with a direction to both the Insurance Companies to deposit crossed-cheques in the sum of Rs.7,50,000/- i.e. Rs.3,75,000/- by the Bharti AXA Ins. Co. Ltd. (now ICICI Lombard GIC) and Rs.3,75,000/- by Cholamandalam Gen. Ins. Co. Ltd. in the name of the appellant No.1-Kamlesh Devi with the office of the Lok Adalat of the High Court on or before 02.05.2025 failing which the amount will carry 9% interest p.a. From the date of this order till the cheque is deposited with the office of the Lok Adalat. The appellant's counsel/appellant may collect the cheque from the office of the Lok Adalat.

Copy of the order/statement be supplied /sent to the counsel/parties and file be returned to the High Court.
