1. Prayer made in the present petition is for directing the respondents to decide the representation dated 04.12.2003, reminder thereof and representation dated 10.11.2004.

2. A perusal of the reply filed by respondent No.3 reveals that amounts have already been paid to the petitioner, which had not been controverted by filing any replication, relevant paras whereof read thus:-

“4. That the contents of para-4 are again false, as the salary shown in the statement given in this Hon'ble Court is Rs.7,531/- and after deducting Rs.455/- towards the contribution of provident fund, net of Rs.7,076 was paid to the petitioner and, as such, nothing more is to be paid to the petitioner employee,

5. That the salary shown in the statement given in this Court is Rs.7,711/- and after deducting the salary for one day on account of leave without pay, i.e. Rs.249/-, a sum of Rs.7,462/- has been correctly paid to the petitioner As such, nothing more is required to be paid to her.

6. That the salary shown in the statement given to this Court for the month April, 2004, is Rs.7,803/- and after deducting one day salary, i.e. Rs.257/- on account of leave without pay, a sum of Rs.7,546/- was correctly paid to the petitioner and the same has been audited in the annual audit and found correct.

7. That the salary shown in the statement given to this Court for the month December, 2004 is Rs.7,803/- and after deducting three days

salary, i.e. Rs.755/- on account of leave without pay, a sum of Rs.7,048/- was correctly paid to the petitioner and the same has been audited in the annual audit and found correct.

9. That the petitioner was entitled to a sum of Rs.62,598/- being the arrears of difference from January, 1996 to March, 1999. BT (Pension Fund) of Rs.12,141/- was deducted and a sum of Rs.50,457/- has been paid to her, i.e. Rs.28,536/- (Rs.4756 x 6) were given earlier and remaining Rs.21,918/- was included in the revised payment of Rs.1,04,320/-. Thus every penny has been paid to the petitioner.

10. That the General provident fund statement of the petitioner for the period April 1998 to March, 1999 at the rate of Rs.146/- per month i.e. $146 \times 12 = \text{Rs.}1752/-$
