1. Present petition has been filed praying for directing respondents No.2 & 3 to issue appropriate directions to conduct fair, impartial and proper proceedings by taking strict legal action against respondents No.5 & 6 as they have brutally attacked and inflicted grievous injuries to the petitioner in view of the law settled by the Hon'ble Apex Court in case "Lalita Kumari vs. Government of U.P. & others, reported as 2014(1) SCC (CrI.) 525", despite informing the police, no FIR has been registered and only a Daily Diary Report (DDR) has been recorded as the police officials have failed to take appropriate action against the accused, police officials are hand-in-glove with respondents No.5 & 6. Further prayer has been made for directing respondents No.2 & 3 to protect the life & liberty of the petitioner and his family members at the hands of accused persons, i.e. respondents No.5 & 6.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner and the complainant, both are practicing as Advocates. He has



submitted that the petitioner has suffered the injuries as is evident from the MLR but the Investigating Agencies are not proceeding with the investigation. He has further submitted that for the redressal of his grievance, the petitioner has already filed the representation dated 11.03.2025 (Annexure P-4) to respondent No.3, however no action has been taken on the same so far.

3. Notice of motion to the official respondents at this stage.

4. On asking of the Court, Mr. Tarun Aggarwal, Sr. DAG, Punjab appears and accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1 to 4-State. He, on instructions from ASI Karamjit Singh, has submitted that DDR No.40, dated 19.02.2025 has already been registered and the investigation is under progress. He has submitted that the investigation would be completed expeditiously.

5. In view of the above position, the present petition stands disposed of with a direction to the respondents-State to take into consideration the grievances raised in the representation filed by the petitioner dated 11.03.2025 (Annexure P-4) to respondent No.3, i.e. Commissioner of Police, Amritsar, before finalizing the same in accordance with law within a period of two weeks from the date of receipt of copy of the order.
