**MANJARI NEHRU KAUL, J. (ORAL)**

1. The petitioner is seeking the concession of anticipatory bail, under Section 482 of BNSS, 2023, in FIR No.185, dated 25.09.2015, under Sections 420, 406, 120-B of IPC, registered at Police Station Navi Baradari, District Jalandhar City (Annexure P-1) as well as in complaint case bearing No.COMI-95-2020, dated 19.02.2020, under Sections 420, 406, 465, 471 of IPC, registered at Police Station Division No.6, Jalandhar.

2. On the last date of hearing i.e. 25.04.2025, this Court had directed the petitioner to appear and surrender before the Trial Court and on his appearance, he has been ordered to be admitted to interim bail on his furnishing bail bonds to the satisfaction of Trial Court/Duty Magistrate.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance of order dated 25.04.2025, petitioner has surrendered before the Trial Court and vide order dated 01.05.2025 passed by learned Judicial Magistrate First

Class, Jalandhar, he has been admitted to bail. Learned counsel has produced copy of order dated 01.05.2025, which is taken on record.

4. In view of the above, the petition is allowed and interim order dated 25.04.2025, is made absolute subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C./482(2) of BNSS, 2023.
