Main case

1. The petitioner has filed the present petition under Section 482 of B.N.S.S with a prayer to grant anticipatory bail to him in case FIR No.061, dated 21.04.2025, under Sections 115(2), 126(2), 191(3), 190, 351(1), 351(3) of BNS, 2023 and Section 304 of BNS added later on, registered at Police Station Sadar Shri Muktsar Sahib.



2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance of the order dated 06.06.2025 passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined the investigation.

4. Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Sukhpal also submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation and is no longer required for further investigation.

5. In view of the above statement made by learned counsel for the parties, the interim order dated 06.06.2025 is made absolute. The petitioner shall continue to join the investigation, as and when called by the Investigating Officer. The petitioner shall also abide by the conditions as specified under Section 482 (2) of B.N.S.S.
