S. J. VAZIFDAR, CHIEF JUSTICE (Oral):

This is an application under section 11 of the Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996, for appointment of a sole Arbitrator.

2. The parties had entered into a contract which admittedly contains an arbitration clause. The petitioners, by their letter dated 21.02.2017, invoked the arbitration agreement. There is no reply to the letter.

3. The civil suit filed by the petitioners for injunction has, in any event, been withdrawn.

4. In the circumstances, the petition is disposed of by appointing Mr. Justice Rameshwar Singh Malik, former Judge of this Court, as the sole Arbitrator. The parties, however, agree that the arbitration proceedings shall be held in Delhi and not in Fari dabad as provided by the arbitration agreement.
