1. This revision petition has been filed by the plaintiff to assail the correctness of interlocutory order passed by the trial court on 13.01.2025 while dismissing his application for amendment of the plaint.
2. The suit filed by the plaintiff is pending for the last 9 years and the plaintiff has already concluded his evidence. In substance, the plaintiff claims that he has been forcibly dispossessed from some portion of the suit property on 13.04.2018 i.e. during the pendency of the suit and now he wants to add the relief of possession.
4. The court has dismissed his application for amendment on the ground of delay because the application was filed on 07.10.2022.
5. The learned counsel representing the petitioner submits that he has already led his evidence and he is only required to make formal amendment.
6. This court has considered the submissions of the learned counsel representing the petitioner.



7. The suits are required to be decided expeditiously. As per order VII CPC, the court has the power to mould the relief if the petitioner successfully proves that he was dispossessed from some portion of the suit property during the pendency of the suit.

8. With these observations, the revision petition is disposed of.

9. All the pending miscellaneous applications, if any, are also disposed of.
