This petition has been filed, *inter alia*, seeking a writ of mandamus directing the respondents to grant/release the benefits to the petitioner as per Clause 11 of the Teacher Transfer Policy, 2016 (amended time to time) (Annexures P-1 and P-2, dated 01.06.2017 and 13.04.2022 respectively).

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that at this stage, the petitioner will be satisfied in case she is permitted to make a fresh representation before the respondents raising the grievance as has been raised in this petition, and the same may be ordered to be decided within a specified period.

4. Ms. Tanushree Gupta, Deputy Advocate General, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents/State and submits that in case any such representation is filed by the petitioner within two weeks from today, the same will be decided by respondent no.2/Director General, Secondary

Education, by passing a speaking/reasoned order in accordance with law within a period of three months by affording due opportunity of hearing.

7. In case the order is not passed within the stipulated period, the officer concerned shall pay costs of ₹50,000 to the petitioner.
