**RUPINDERJIT CHAHAL, J. (ORAL)**

1. Through the instant petition filed under Section 482 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 (For short "BNSS"), the petitioner seeks anticipatory bail in case FIR No.0130 dated 28.06.2025 under Sections 333, 115(2), 191(3), 190 BNS (Section 117(2) BNS added later on), registered at Police Station City Budhlada, District Mansa (Annexure P-1)

2. On 13.08.2025, following order had been passed: -

*“ By way of present petition filed under Section 482 BNSS, 2023, the petitioner seeks anticipatory bail in case FIR (Annexure P-1) as under:*

*Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner has been falsely implicated in the present case and has nothing to do with the alleged occurrence. Further, the co-accused namely Gurpreet Singh and Gursewak Singh @ Golu @ Nai have already been granted the concession of bail by the Court of learned Sub Divisional Judicial Magistrate, Budhlada vide order dated 18.07.2025. He further contends that the petitioner is ready*



*and willing to join the investigation as and when called upon to do so by the investigating agency.*

*Notice of motion.*

*On asking of the Court, Mr. Subhash Godara, Addl. A.G., Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of respondent-State and seeks time to file reply in the matter.*

*Adjourned to 24.09.2025.*

*In the meanwhile, the petitioner is directed to join investigation within a week from today and would appear as and when required by the Investigating Officer and cooperate with the Investigating Agency. In the event of arrest, he shall be admitted to interim bail on furnishing personal and surety bonds to the satisfaction of Arresting/Investigating Officer. He shall also abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 482(2) of BNSS, 2023.*

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance of the order dated 13.08.2025 passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined the investigation.

4. Learned counsel for the State, on instructions from ASI Sukhcharan Singh, has submitted that the petitioner has joined the investigation and is no longer required for further investigation.

5. In view of the statement made by learned State counsel, the interim order dated 13.08.2025 is made absolute. The petitioner shall continue to join investigation, as and when called by the Investigating Officer and shall also abide by the conditions as provided under Section 482(2) of the BNSS.
