1. In the present petition, the petitioner has challenged the action of respondent No.3 in terminating the services of the petitioner retrospectively w.e.f. 31.12.2020, pursuant to the amendment dated 24.09.2020 made in Rule 19(A) of the Punjab State Cooperative Agricultural Services Societies Service Rules, 1997, which has since been set aside by this Court vide order dated 09.08.2024. The petitioner is also praying for direction to the respondents to release the salary due to him for the period from 01.01.2021 to 31.12.2021.

2. Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner, on instructions from petitioner, further submits that at this stage, he will be satisfied if the present writ petition be treated as a representation and a direction is given to respondent No.3 to decide the same by passing an appropriate speaking order in a time bound manner.
