**HARPREET SINGH BRAR, J. (ORAL)**

1. This petition has been filed under Section 528 of BNSS, 2023 seeking quashing of FIR No.56, dated 11.04.2025, under Sections 125 & 125(a) of BNS and Sections 25 & 27 of Arms Act, 1959, registered at Police Station Koom Kalan, District Ludhiana (Annexure P-1) and all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom in view of the compromise dated 28.04.2025 (Annexure P-2).

2. The following order was passed by this Court on 26.05.2025:-

**“This petition has been filed under Section 528  
BNSS, 2023 seeking quashing of FIR No.56 dated  
11.04.2025 under Sections 125, 125(a) of BNS and  
Sections 25 and 27 of Arms Act, 1959 registered at  
Police Station Koom Kalan, District Ludhiana  
(Annexure P-1) along with all subsequent proceedings  
arising therefrom on the basis of compromise dated  
28.04.2025 (Annexure P-2).**

**Notice of motion.**



At this stage, on the asking of the Court, Mr. Subhash Godara, Addl. A.G., Punjab accepts notice on behalf of respondent No.1-State and Mr. Saurav Kanojia, Advocate accepts notice for respondent No.2 and files his power of attorney, which is taken on record. He admits to the factum of compromise. Copy of the paper book be supplied to them during the course of day.

Service is complete.

Adjourned to 28.07.2025.

In the meanwhile, the parties are directed to appear before the learned trial Court/Illaq Magistrate within two weeks from today or any other date convenient to the trial Court/Illaq Magistrate, to get recorded their statements regarding compromise and after recording their statements, learned trial Court/Illaq Magistrate is directed to send report regarding the genuineness of compromise and also to intimate whether any PO proceedings are pending against any of the party on or before the date fixed.

A copy of the order be sent to learned trial Court/Illaq Magistrate through fax for compliance.”

3. In compliance of the above order, a report has been received from the concerned jurisdictional Court that the compromise between the parties is genuine and arrived at without any pressure or coercion from anyone.

4. In view of the compromise and the ratio of law laid down by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in *Narinder Singh and others vs. State of Punjab and another*, (2014) 6 SCC 46, and *Shakuntala Sawhney (Mrs) Vs. Kaushalya (Mrs.) and others* (1980) 1 SCC 63 and Full Bench of this Court in *Kulwinder Singh Vs. State of Punjab* 2007 (3) RCR (Crl) 1052, this



petition is allowed and FIR No.56, dated 11.04.2025, under Sections 125 & 125(a) of BNS and Sections 25 & 27 of Arms Act, 1959, registered at Police Station Koom Kalan, District Ludhiana (Annexure P-1) and all subsequent proceedings arising out of the same are quashed, qua the petitioners.
