1. This is a second petition under Section 483 of the B.N.S.S. with a prayer for grant of interim bail for 20 days to the petitioner in FIR no.132 dated 23.09.2024 registered under Section 18 (C) of the NDPS Act, 1985 at Police Station Adampur, District Jalandhar Rural.
2. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the father of the petitioner has died on 27.12.2024 and his Pagari Rasam is to be performed on 04.01.2025 and on 15.01.2025, Bhog ceremony is also to be performed. It is prayed that for the said purpose, the petitioner be granted interim bail for 20 days in the said FIR.
3. On the other hand, learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Kuldeep Kumar, has submitted that in the present case, the co-accused

of the petitioner i.e., Deepak, has been granted the interim bail by the Coordinate Bench of this Court but has directed that he would be taken on 04.01.2025 for performing Pagri Rasam as well as on 15.01.2025 for the Bhog ceremony in police custody and the Jail Superintendent has been directed to do the needful.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner has not disputed the fact that the Coordinate Bench has passed the order as averred by the learned State counsel.

5. Keeping in view the abovesaid facts and circumstances and also in view of the fact that in similar circumstances, the order has been passed by the Coordinate Bench of this Court, the present petition is partly allowed and the concerned Jail Superintendent is directed to permit the petitioner to go for Pagri Rasam to be performed on 04.01.2025 as well as Bhog ceremony to be held on 15.01.2025 with respect to the death of his father, in police custody.

6. Pending application, if any, stands disposed of in view of the abovesaid order.
