1. Counsel for the petitioner inter alia submits that earlier the petitioner was declared proclaimed person vide order dated 29.05.2023 Annexure P-4 which is under challenge in the present petition wherein the petitioner is already given permission to join the proceedings before the trial



Court subject to deposit of cost worth Rs.10000/-. The petitioner in compliance of the said order, joined the proceedings before the trial Court and also deposited the requisite amount, as is evident from order dated 16.10.2023 passed by the Court below. The copy of the said order is placed on record. Counsel for the petitioner further submits that in light of the above, the order of interim bail dated 11.10.2023 passed by this Court deserves to be made absolute.

2. The State counsel on instructions from ASI Tarsem Singh submits that in compliance of order dated 11.10.2023, the petitioner is regularly appearing before the trial Court and now the trial has reached its advance stage and is fixed for 11.02.2025 for final arguments.

3. In view of the above, without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed and order of interim bail dated 11.10.2023 is hereby made absolute subject to the conditions as envisaged under Section 482 (2) of BNSS, 2023.

4. Needless to say that the petitioner shall keep on appearing regularly before the trial Court on each and every date of hearing in future also.
