SHEEL NAGU, CHIEF JUSTICE (Oral)

1. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that FIR, which triggered prosecution against the petitioners, i.e. FIR No. 192 dated 05.10.2024, under Sections 406 and 420 IPC, registered at Police Station Division No.8, District Jalandhar, has since been quashed by the Co-ordinate Bench vide order dated 22.01.2025 passed in CRM-M-65414-2025, and thus, the cause raised herein has become infructuous.

2. Learned counsel for the State of Punjab does not dispute the aforesaid subsequent development.

3. Accordingly, the petition stands dismissed as infructuous.
