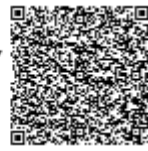

1. The petitioner incarcerated in the FIR captioned above has come up before this Court under Section 483 of Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023, [BNSS], seeking regular bail.
2. Vide order dated 17.02.2025, the petitioner was granted interim bail/ protection, which continues the date.
3. Counsel for the petitioner submits that he has voluntarily supplied the affidavit wherein all his assets to State counsel as well counsel for the complainant and undertakes that he would not claim such declaration as any incrimination or violation of their rights under Articles 20/21 of the Constitution of India, Bharatiya Sakshya Adhinyam, 2023 or any other law in force. The petitioner's counsel argued that the custodial investigation would serve no purpose whatsoever and the further pre-trial incarceration would cause an irreversible injustice to the petitioner and family.
4. The State's counsel as well as counsel for the complainant opposes bail.
5. The petitioner was granted interim protection, and during the interregnum, there is no allegation that he had intimidated the witnesses, hampered the investigation. Petitioner already declared his assets as per the format of this Court. Given the above, there would be no justification to discontinue the interim protection, which is made absolute.
