Status report by way of an affidavit of Mr. Nitin Kumar Yadav, IAS, Home Secretary, Chandigarh Administration filed in Registry of this Court is taken on record.

Learned counsel for the respondent on instructions submits that two Home Guards namely, Sandeep and Sohan Lal have been temporarily posted in the office of Punjab Human Rights Commission to undertake the clerical work relating to the U.T. cases in addition to the two police personnel already in place for investigation purposes.
