**JAGMOHAN BANSAL, J. (Oral)**

1. The petitioner through instant petition under Articles 226 and 227 of the Constitution of India is seeking setting aside of order dated 19.05.2025 (Annexure P-13) whereby respondent has put his land on auction.
2. On being confronted, Mr. Sunil K. Nehra concedes that petitioner has preferred appeal against orders whereby liability has been created against him. The appeal is pending before Deputy Commissioner, Sirsa.
3. The petitioner has remedy to seek stay from Appellate Authority.



4. Faced with this, Mr. Sunil K. Nehra submits that petitioner would file stay application, if not filed till date, by Monday i.e. 02.06.2025. The respondent may be directed to decide stay application before the date fixed for auction.

5. Ms. Rajni Gupta, Addl. A.G., Haryana, who on advance notice is present in Court, submits that if petitioner files stay application on or before 02.06.2025, it would be decided expeditiously and preferably by 04.06.2025.

6. In the wake of statement of both sides, instant petition stands disposed of.

7. It is made clear that if petitioner files stay application before Deputy Commissioner, Sirsa by 02.06.2025, the auction would not be conducted till the adjudication of stay application.
