AUGUSTINE GEORGE MASIH, J. (ORAL)

Petitioners have approached this Court alleging violation of the order passed by this Court on 01.04.2015 (Annexure P-1) passed by this Court in CWP No. 19880 of 2014 preferred by the petitioners, whereby directions were issued to the respondents to consider the representation of the petitioners to be submitted by them within a specified time. In compliance with the order passed by this Court on 01.04.2015, representations dated 30.04.2015 (Annexure P-2) and dated 14.05.2015 (Annexure P-3) were submitted by the petitioners. Those representations have been decided by the Deputy Director, O/o Director General, Urban Estates, Haryana, vide order dated 14.07.2017 (Annexure R-1), which is appended along with the reply filed to the contempt petition.

Counsel for the petitioners prays for an adjournment as the counsel for the petitioners is not available today.

Keeping in view the fact that a limited direction was issued by this Court and that too, without going into the merits of the case with a direction to the limited extent of deciding the representation to be submitted by the petitioners and the said representation having been decided in the considered view of this Court, the present contempt petition does not survive.

In the light of the above, the request of the proxy counsel for the petitioners is not accepted.

Contempt petition is disposed of as infructuous. Liberty is, however, granted to the petitioners to avail of their remedy, in accordance with law, if so advised.

Rule issued to the respondents stands discharged.
