Prayer in the present petition is for issuance of direction to respondent No.2 to 3 to comply with the provisions Section 160 Cr.P.C. (now Section 179 of BNSS) read with Section 41 Cr.P.C. (now Section 35 of BNSS) and further in view of law laid down by Hon'ble Supreme Court in Arnesh Kumar vs. State of Bihar, 2014 (3) RCR 527.

It has been submitted by learned counsel for the petitioner that the petitioner is being harassed by respondents No.3 to 7. She submits that the petitioner has already filed representation dated 02.06.2025 (Annexure P-3) before respondent No.2, but no action has been taken on the same till date. She further submits that the respondent-authorities are to proceed as per the law settled by Hon'ble Supreme Court in Arnesh Kumar's (supra).

After hearing learned counsel for the parties, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 i.e. Senior Superintendent of Police, Sangrur, to decide the representation filed by the petitioner within a period of four weeks from today, in accordance with law.
