Prayer in this second petition is for issuance of a direction to the Arresting Officer/learned Trial Court to release the petitioners on bail in the event of their arrest in case FIR No.32 dated 29.3.2024 (Annexure P-1) under Sections 465, 467, 468, 471 and 120-B IPC and Sections 3, 4, 5, and 6 of Immoral Traffic Act (added later on), registered at Police Station Sarabha Nagar, District Police Commissionerate Ludhiana.

Perusal of the order-sheet(s) shows that on the last date of hearing i.e. 03.1.2025 there was no appearance on behalf of petitioner and the case was adjourned for today i.e. 24.1.2025. Even today, there is no representation on behalf of the petitioner, despite the case having been called twice. Therefore, it can safely be presumed that the petitioner or his counsel are no more interested in pursuing the instant petition. Thus, this Court is left with no other option except to dismiss the same for non-prosecution.
