1. The instant criminal writ petition has been filed under Article 226 of Constitution of India for issuance of directions to respondent Nos.2 to 4 for protecting the life and liberty of the petitioner at the hands of respondent Nos.5 to 7 and to take appropriate legal action on the complaint/representations dated 07.07.2025 and 19.07.2025 (Annexures P-4 and P-5 respectively).

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that the petitioner has moved representations to respondent No.2-Commissioner of Police, Jalandhar regarding the threats given by the private respondents, but no action has been taken.

3. On advance notice, learned State counsel appeared and on instructions from ACP Security Jalandhar, submitted that the authorities are looking into the representations moved by the petitioner.
