**KULDEEP TIWARI, J.** (Oral)

1. After arguing the matter extensively, when confronted with the provisions of Section 23 of the Maintenance and Welfare of Parents and Senior Citizens Act, 2007, learned counsel for the petitioner fairly concedes that the applications, as preferred by the applicant-petitioner before the learned Tribunal concerned, were, in fact, not maintainable. Therefore, he submits that he may be permitted to withdraw the original applications, with liberty to the petitioner to raise all such pleas, as has been raised through the original applications, before the apt forum/Court, by filing a civil suit or avail such other remedies, as shall be admissible, in law. He also seeks permission to withdraw the instant petitions.
