1. Present petition has been filed praying for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.2, dated 05.01.2025, under Sections 318(4) of Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023 and Sections 66(c) and 66(D) of Information Technology Act, 2000, registered at Police Station Cyber Crime, District Fazilka.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner prays for withdrawal of this petition with liberty to the petitioner to surrender and file an appropriate application for bail before the trial Court. He further prays that direction be issued to learned trial Court to decide his bail application in a time bound manner.
