The appellant-plaintiff had filed the suit for declaration to the effect that order dated 26.05.1988 passed by defendant No.3 vide which the services of the appellant-plaintif had been terminated, was illegal, null and void. The said suit was dismissed by the trial Court and even the appeal filed by the appellant-plaintiff was dismissed by the first Appellate Court.

2. On 11.07.2024, none had appeared on behalf of the appellant and accordingly, notice was issued to the appellant.

3. Even today, none has appeared on behalf of the appellant to inform the Court as to whether any cause survives in the present appeal.
