**MANISHA BATRA, J. (Oral)**

1. Status report has been filed. Learned Assistant Advocate General, Punjab assisted by learned counsel for the complainant has submitted that the petitioner has joined the investigation on 08.10.2024. It is, however, simultaneously submitted by them that the petitioner had lodged a cross version which was found to be false after conducting thorough investigation. Serious injuries on the person of three persons have been attributed to him and, therefore, it is urged that he does not deserve to be extended benefit of pre arrest bail.

2. As mentioned above, the petitioner has joined investigation.

Observation has already been made in the previous order that the question as to who was the aggressor is yet to be determined. The custodial interrogation of the petitioner is not required. As such, no useful purpose would be served by detaining him in custody. In view of the discussion so made, the petition is allowed and the order dated 01.10.2024 whereby the petitioner had been ordered to be released on interim bail is made absolute subject to the compliance of the conditions laid down in Section 482(2) of Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita (BNSS), 2023.
