Main case

1. Petitioner Yashpal @ Billu has filed petition under Section
482 of Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 for grant of anticipatory
bail in case FIR No. 51 dated 13.02.2025 (Annexure P-1) registered under
74, 75(2), 115(3) of Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023 at Police Station Model

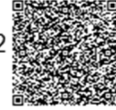

2. Facts of the case are, prosecutrix gave her statement that he is running a tea stall at Brass market main gate, Rewari. On 11.02.2025, at about 07:00-07:30 PM, she was sitting in tea stall where Billu Gurjar and another person came and asked for a cigarette. She took out cigarette from her shop and gave it to him. He was drunk. His other companion asked Billu Gurjar to leave. Other person went away, thereafter, Billu Gurjar gave her a bite on her cheek and on protest raised by her, he grappled her. She was pulled out of the shop and started giving her kick blows, punches and twisted her forearm. Huge crowd gathered there and she was rescued from him. Somebody in crowd gave brickbat blow which hit on his head. Thereafter, Billu Gurjar left the spot.

3. Learned counsel for petitioner argued that allegations levelled against petitioner are false. In fact, he was caused injury by prosecutrix on her head. Copy of MLR is Annexure P/3. Petitioner is victim. He is ready to join investigation. It is prayed that his anticipatory bail petition may be allowed.

4. Bail petition is opposed by learned counsel representing State. There are specific serious allegations against petitioner. He is specifically named. Copy of MLR of petitioner is Annexure R-1. He is yet to join investigation. Therefore, he does not deserve concession of anticipatory bail.

5. I have considered the arguments and have gone through the record carefully. Prosecutrix has levelled specific allegations against

petitioner, who caused sexual harassment to prosecutrix and outraged her modesty. She was beaten up in public while petitioner was under the influence of liquor. Aforesaid condition of petitioner is confirmed from the copy of MLR annexed with status report as well as produced by learned counsel for petitioner, where it is mentioned that *alcohol smell present from mouth and breath*. He had refused to give blood sample. There is reference of one lacerated wound present over the left parietal region of his head. Therefore, version of prosecutrix is confirmed from medical record of petitioner. He is yet to join investigation. Considering the aforesaid factual position, in my opinion, petitioner Yashpal @ Billu is not entitled to be released on anticipatory bail and same is, accordingly, dismissed.

6. Pending miscellaneous application(s), if any, stand disposed of accordingly as well.
