



**BEFORE THE NATIONAL LOK ADALAT,
PUNJAB AND HARYANA HIGH COURT, CHANDIGARH**

As agreed, as per statement of learned counsel for the appellants (separately recorded) and learned counsel for the Insurance Company (separately recorded), a sum of Rs.2,80,000/- (Rupees Two Lac Eighty Thousand Only) over and above the amount awarded by the Tribunal is allowed to the appellants, in full and final settlement of the claim in this appeal. As per the statement of learned counsel for the appellants, the enhanced amount is to be paid to all the appellants in the same ratio as apportioned by the learned MACT.

Accordingly, we dispose of the present appeal with a direction to the Insurance Company to deposit crossed-cheque(s) for an amount of Rs.2,80,000/- (Rupees Two Lac Eighty Thousand Only), in the name of all the appellants with the office of the Lok Adalat of the High Court within a period of 04 weeks from today, in compliance of this order, failing which, interest @ 7% per annum shall follow on the above-said amount till payment from the date of this order. The concerned Officer of the Lok Adalat Branch/Office shall issue proper receipt, after receiving the cheque(s), to learned counsel/representative of the respondent-Insurance Company. The appellant(s)' counsel/appellant(s) may collect the cheque(s) from the office of the Lok Adalat.

Pending civil miscellaneous application, if any, stands disposed of.

Copy of the order be supplied/sent to the counsel/parties and file be returned to the Hon'ble High Court.
