The present petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India seeking issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus for directing the official respondents No.1 to 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners at the hands of respondent No.4 and to take necessary action on the representation dated 30.07.2025 (Annexure P-5) of the petitioner.

2. At the very outset, learned counsel for the petitioners has submitted that he would be satisfied if appropriate directions are issued to respondent No.2 to decide or take necessary action on the aforesaid representation filed by the petitioners raising their grievance which has not been considered and no action has been taken till now.

3. Notice of motion.

4. Ms. Ramta Chowdhary, learned DAG, Punjab, who is present in Court, has accepted the notice on behalf of the respondents-State and submits

that the needful will be done in due course. Let a complete set of the paperbook be supplied to her during the course of the day.

5. In view of the limited prayer made by the petitioners, without commenting anything on the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of at this stage with a direction to respondent No.2 to decide the aforesaid representation dated 30.07.2025 (Annexure P-5) of the petitioners within a period of 15 days from today, by passing a speaking order in accordance with law.
