1. Case is being taken up for hearing through Video Conferencing due to the outbreak of Covid-19 pandemic.
2. Prayer in the petition under Sections 11 & 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, is for initiating action against the respondents for willful and deliberate disobedience of Order (Annexure P-1) dated 28.11.2018, in CWP No.29982 of 2018, in case titled as 'Sheela versus State of Haryana and another'.
3. Learned counsel contends that vide Order (Annexure P-1) dated 28.11.2018, CWP No.29982 of 2018, was disposed of by directing the respondents to decide legal notice dated 20.08.2018 by passing a speaking order within a period of 03 months from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order and in case on decision, the petitioner was found entitled to any monetary benefits, the same be released to her within a period of 03 months thereafter but despite lapse of the stipulated period of time, needful has not been done.
4. Notice to the respondents to show cause as to why proceedings

under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971 be not initiated against them for non-compliance with Order (Annexure P-1) dated 28.11.2018, passed in CWP No.29982 of 2018, in case titled as 'Sheela versus State of Haryana and another'.

5. Ms. Kirti Singh, DAG, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents and has filed copy of order dated 29.09.2020, passed by respondent No.2 in compliance of order dated 28.11.2018, in CWPNo.29982 of 2018. The same is taken on record. Copy thereof supplied to learned counsel for the petitioner.

6. Learned counsel for the petitioner on perusal of the order dated 29.09.2020, states that since the grievance of the petitioner has been redressed, he does not press the instant contempt petition and may be permitted to withdraw the same.

7. In view of the statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, the contempt petition is ***dismissed as withdrawn.***
