This common order shall dispose off the present two appeals as  
the same have arisen out of common judgment(s) and decree(s).

[2] By way of present appeal(s), challenge has been laid to the  
judgment and decree dated 31.08.2015 passed by the Court of Additional  
District Judge, Kurukshetra (**hereinafter to be referred as "First Appellate**

Court”), whereby an appeal filed against the judgment and decree dated 13.10.2014 passed by the Court of Civil Judge (Junior Division), Pehowa (hereinafter to be referred as “trial Court”), partly decreeing the suit for declaration, filed at the instance of respondent-plaintiff, was allowed.

[3] Vide order dated 22.01.2025, with the consent of learned counsel for the parties, the matter was referred before the Mediation and Conciliation Centre of this Court.

[4] Now, a report has been received from the Mediation and Conciliation Centre, as per which, the parties have settled their dispute amicably by way of settlement / agreement dated 22.01.2025, which is placed at Flag-A; taken on record as **Mark-‘X’** and the same be read as part of the order.

[5] In view of the aforesaid settlement, learned counsel for the appellants-defendants does not press the present appeals any further and wishes to withdraw the same.

[6] Both the appeals are **dismissed as withdrawn**.

[7] It is made clear that in case any of the party, violates the terms and conditions of the agreement / settlement dated 22.01.2025, they would be at liberty to seek recalling of the present order.

[8] Pending miscellaneous application(s), if any, shall also stand disposed off.
