SUDEEPTI SHARMA, J. (Oral)

1. With the consent of learned counsel for the parties, ten civil original contempt petitions shall stand disposed of by this common order (details whereof are given at the header of the order).
2. The contempt petitions have been filed for deliberate and intentional disobedience of order dated 19.02.2025, passed by this Court.
3. In all the contempt petitions, a common compliance report has been filed.
4. Sh. Sukhdeep Singh Parmar, learned counsel appearing on behalf of respondent No.1 and 2 in COCP-3595 & 2896-2025, submits that he adopts the compliance report along with Annexure R-1/1 filed on behalf of respondent No.1 and 2 in COCP-3037, 3038, 3042, 3043, 3047, 3048, 3062, 3217 of 2025.
5. Para 4 of the compliance report dated 18.07.2025, is reproduced as under:-



“4. That the department has called all the petitioners for personal hearing who were 128 in Number through video conferencing and mostly the petitioners have put their claim before the competent authority UHBVNL. After hearing the petitioners, the competent authority have accepted the claim of two candidates i.e. No. 2 (Hemraj) & No. 4 (Pawan) whereas rejected the request of the remaining petitioners by passing a well-reasoned detailed speaking order vide No. 153/UH/GA-604/CC dated 08.07.2025 (Annexure- R-1/1) because they are ineligible for the inter-utility transfer.”

6. In compliance of order dated 19.02.2025, speaking order dated 08.07.2025, has been passed.

7. In view of the above, all the civil original contempt petitions are dismissed. The contempt is purged and rule is discharged.
