Petitioner alleges wilful disobedience of the order dated 29.09.2015 passed by the Writ Court in CWP No.13837 of 2015.

2. Counsel for the petitioner is not in position to deny that the petitioner was not party to the writ petition. Leave aside the question of *locus* even the contempt petition has been filed after expiry of the limitation as prescribed under Section 20 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971.
