1. Learned counsel for the petitioner argues that the petitioner has a valid stage carriage permit on the route Batala to Madhipur but in the time table, timings have not been allotted to the petitioner, which is causing prejudice to the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has already raised the said grievance in the legal notice dated 15.05.2025 (Annexure P-6), which is still pending consideration with the respondents and the petitioner will be satisfied, at this stage, in case a direction is issued to the respondents to decide the same by passing an appropriate speaking order in a time bound manner.

In case, it is found feasible to accept the claim of the petitioner, the same will be accepted, otherwise due reasons for not accepting the claim of the petitioner will be mentioned in the speaking order so passed which order will be conveyed to the petitioner for its information and necessary action.

5. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that keeping in view the statement of learned counsel for the respondents, the present petition may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further.
