Prayer in the present petition is for directing the respondents to decide the representation of the petitioner in a time bound manner.

Precise submissions made by counsel for the petitioner is that the petitioner is an accused in FIR No.739 of 2023, under Sections 408, 381, 34, 454, 380 and 411 of IPC, P.S. Chandni Bagh, Panipat where he has been falsely implicated. He submits that when the petitioner was behind the bars, his household articles were taken by the police. It is submitted that for the redressal of his grievance, petitioner has filed representation dated 15.10.2024 (Annexure P-1) before respondent No.2-Commissioner of Police, Sonipat but the same has not been taken into consideration by the said respondent till date. He submits that the investigation in the FIR registered against the petitioner is still under progress.
