1. The petitioner herein is defendant No.1 in a plaintiff's suit for grant of decree of permanent injunction restraining the defendant from interfering in her possession. The suit was filed in the year 2015. The defendant examined as many as 17 witnesses. Subsequently, he filed the application for recall of official of PSPCL and his former tenant for further examination, which has been dismissed by the trial Court. The petitioner claims that the official of PSPCL is required to be questioned as to how the date of installation of meter is being changed. He further submits that tenant is required to be recalled for the same purpose.

2. In a suit for injunction filed by the plaintiff, the only evidence, which is required to be led is to prove as to who is entitled to possession and is in settled possession. The evidence sought to be produced by the defendant is neither relevant nor *germane* to the controversy involved.

3. Hence, dismissed.
