1. The present Contempt Petition under Sections 10 and 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act has been filed by the petitioner/grand-father of the minor child/son of the respondent herein, for initiating contempt proceedings against the respondent for willfully disobeying the order dated 12.07.2019 (Annexure P-5) passed by the learned Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Yamuna Nagar at Jagadhri in case bearing COMA No. 140 of 2015 titled as 'Anoopa Saini vs. Arvind Saini and others'.

2. Vide order dated 12.07.2019, it was directed as under:-

*"2. Rather, this Court is of the opinion that meeting of grandfather with minor Aarav in his School at lunch time for half an hour, on alternative Monday and Saturday of a week, will not only satisfy the spirit of order passed on dated 07.05.2019 but also will not have any adverse impact upon minor Aarav. Therefore, frame work of visitation and its frequencies is hereby decided in afore-referred manner. Copy of this order be provided to petitioner as well as respondent no.2, if such request is made. Further, copy of this order be sent to Principal of the School in which currently minor Aarav is studying. Regarding the address of school, respondent no.2 is directed to supply the address to concerned Ahlmad Sh.Pritam Singh. Now, the case is*



*adjourned to 14.08.2019 checking the execution of the directions as well as for further proceedings.”*

3. Reply dated 28.04.2025, filed in Court on behalf of the respondent is taken on record. A copy thereof, has been supplied to learned counsel for the petitioner.

4. At the very outset, learned counsel for the respondent undertakes that aforesaid direction shall be complied with in *toto* from the next date of hearing before the learned trial Court which is stated to be 28.08.2025. He further undertakes that the minor child shall not be taken away from the school on the alternative Monday and Saturday, as recorded by the Principal, DAV Centenary Public School, Radaur (Yamuna Nagar) in Annexures P-11 and 12.

5. In view of the above, no further orders are required to be passed in the present petition, the same stands **disposed of**, accordingly.

6. It is, however, made clear that in case, respondent fails to comply with the order dated 12.07.2019 (Annexure P-5), the petitioner would be at liberty to again approach this Court.

7. Rule stands discharged.

8. Pending application(s), if any, shall also stand disposed of.
