1. The present revision petition has been preferred under Article 227 of the Constitution of India seeking a direction to the Court of Civil Judge (Jr. Division), Barnala, to decide the application under Order 39 Rules 1 and 2 where Civil Suit No. 1156 of 2024, titled as 'Jagtar Singh and another Vs. Gurlal Singh', is pending.

2. Notice to the defendant was issued in the civil suit vide order dated 21.09.2024. The defendant put in appearance through counsel on 17.12.2024 after which, the interlocutory orders show that the matter remained pending for filing of written statement, reply to the application under Order 39 Rules 1 and 2 CPC etc., whereafter the matter is pending for arguments on the application. The matter was last listed on 02.07.2025 and it has been stated that no hearing on the application under Order 39 Rules 1 and 2 CPC has taken place.

3. Having gone through the interlocutory orders, the present revision petition is disposed of with a direction to the Court concerned to

hear and decide the application under Order 39 Rules 1 and 2 CPC expeditiously. Needless to assert that valuable rights of the parties are involved in cases and Courts should not delay hearing especially when interim relief is prepared for.
