Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that order dated 23.09.2024 (Annexure P-1) passed by a Division Bench of this Court in LPA No. 1024 of 2022, the willful disobedience of which has been alleged in the instant contempt petition has been set aside by the Supreme Court of India vide order dated 14.07.2025 passed in *SLP (C) No. 23141 of 2024, titled as Mandeep Singh Vs. State of Punjab*. He submits that in view of the same, nothing survives in the instant contempt petition and that he may be permitted to withdraw the same.

2. In view of the statement given by learned counsel for the petitioner, the instant contempt petition is dismissed as having been withdrawn. Rule stands discharged.
