**HARKESH MANUJA, J. (ORAL)**

Learned counsel for the respondent, on instructions from the quarter concerned, submits that the petitioner may appear before the Station House Officer, Women Cell, SAS Nagar (Mohali) on **08.02.2025 at 11.00 a.m.** and her statement shall be recorded; followed by further action, if required. He also assures the Court that in case any merit is found in the statement / complaint submitted by the petitioner, necessary action shall be taken thereupon within a period of two weeks thereafter.

[2] In view of the above undertaking, learned counsel for the petitioner does not press the present petition any further.

[3] **Dismissed as not pressed.**

[4] Rule stands discharged.

[5] It is made clear that in case the needful is not done, as per undertaking given by the learned counsel for respondents, the petitioner

would be at liberty to seek revival of the present contempt petition and in that eventuality, respondent-contemnor shall remain present in Court on the day of listing of such application, besides he / she would be liable to pay litigation costs incurred by the petitioner.

[6] Pending miscellaneous application(s), if any, shall also stand disposed off.
