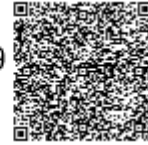

HARKESH MANUJA J. (Oral)

1. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that substantially the order passed by the Writ Court has been complied with, however, with respect to the remaining relief along with interest, if any, he seeks liberty to file representation.

2. In view thereof, no cause survives in the present petition, as such, the same is disposed of.

It is made clear that in case, the petitioner moves representation with respect to remaining relief along with interest, if any, before the quarter concerned within a period of two weeks, the same shall be dealt with, as per law, within a period of four weeks thereafter from the date of its receipt by passing a speaking order thereupon, which shall be conveyed to the petitioner

within a period of two weeks thereafter and in case of any delay on the part of respondent(s), the officer(s) concerned would be liable to pay costs of Rs. 50,000/- to the petitioner from his / her own pocket.

3. Rule stands discharged.
4. Pending application, if any, also stands disposed of.
