AMARINDER SINGH GREWAL, J.

1.. Prayer in the present Civil Revision Petition filed under Article 227 of the Constitution of India is for setting aside the impugned order dated 17.07.2025 (Annexure P-7), passed by the learned Additional Civil Judge (Senior Division), Jind, whereby the learned Court declined to grant *ad interim* injunction to the petitioners restraining respondents/defendants No. 1 to 4 from dispossessing them forcibly and illegally from the land measuring 1 'Bigha' and 16 'Biswas' comprised in 'Killa' No. 660/1/2 (1-18) and agricultural land measuring 2 'Bigha' and 8 'Biswas' comprised in 'Killa' Nos. 505 and 506, which are part and parcel of land comprised in 'Khewat' No. 393, 'Khata' Nos. 474 to 475, situated in the revenue estate of Village Deorar, Tehsil Julana, District Jind, as per the 'Jamabandi' for the year 2020-21.

2. I have heard learned counsel for the parties and perused the paper-book.

3. The impugned order dated 17.07.2025 (Annexure P-7) shows that the written statement was never filed, yet the prayer for granting *ad interim* injunction was declined.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioners has conceded before this Court that the written statement to the injunction application may be permitted to be filed before the learned lower Court and thereafter, the learned lower Court may be directed to decide the injunction application.

5. Accordingly, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to the learned lower Court to ensure that the written statement/reply to the injunction application is filed, whereafter the said application shall be decided expeditiously in accordance with law.

6. Pending miscellaneous application(s), if any, shall also stand disposed of.
