**HARPREET SINGH BRAR, J. (Oral)**

1. Instant petition has been filed under Section 528 of Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita seeking quashing of the FIR No.0002 dated 14.01.2025, registered under Sections 318(4) BNS 2023 at Police Station Cyber Crime Fatehabad, District Fatehabad (Annexure P-1) and all subsequent proceedings arising out of the same, on the basis of compromise dated 14.05.2025 (Annexure P-2).

2. The following order was passed on 22.05.2025 :-

“This petition has been filed under Section 528 BNSS seeking quashing of FIR No.0002 dated 14.01.2025 registered under Sections 318(4) of BNS, 2023 at Police Station Cyber Crime, Fatehabad, District Fatehabad, on the basis of compromise dated 14.05.2025 (Annexure P-2) along with all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom.

Notice of motion for 23.07.2025.



At this stage, on asking of the Court, Ms. Geeta Sharma, DAG, Haryana accepts notice on behalf of respondent No.1 – State and Mr. Davinder Singh Khurana, Advocate accepts notice on behalf of respondent No.2 and files Vakalatnama, which is taken on record. Copy of the paper book be supplied to them during the course of day.

Service is complete.

In the meanwhile, the parties are directed to appear before the learned trial Court/Illaqa Magistrate within two weeks from today or any other date convenient to the trial Court/Illaqa Magistrate, to get their statements recorded regarding compromise and after recording their statements, learned trial Court/Illaqa Magistrate is directed to send report regarding the genuineness of compromise and also to intimate whether any PO proceedings are pending against any of the party on or before the date fixed i.e. 23.07.2025.

A copy of the order be sent to learned trial Court/Illaqa Magistrate through fax for compliance.”

3. In compliance of the aforesaid order, a report has been received from the concerned jurisdictional Court that the compromise between the parties is genuine and arrived at without any pressure or coercion from anyone.

4. In view of the compromise and the ratio of law laid down by the Hon’ble Supreme Court in *Narinder Singh and others vs. State of Punjab and another, (2014) 6 SCC 46*, and *Shakuntala Sawhney (Mrs) Vs. Kaushalya (Mrs.) and others (1980) 1 SCC 63* and Full Bench of this Court in *Kulwinder Singh Vs. State of Punjab 2007 (3) RCR (Crl.) 1052*, this petition is allowed and FIR No.0002 dated 14.01.2025, registered under Sections 318(4) BNS 2023 at Police Station Cyber Crime



Fatehabad, District Fatehabad (Annexure P-1) and all consequential proceedings arising out of the same are quashed, qua the petitioners.
