SUDEEPTI SHARMA J. (ORAL)

1. This case pertains to the category of fully burnt cases of the year 2007. On the last date of hearing, since, learned counsel for the appellants contended that he is not in contact with the appellants, therefore, Registry was directed to inform the appellants about the next date of hearing.
