Prayer in the present petition is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.77 dated 29.10.2024, registered under Sections 331(6), 115(2), 121(1), 122 of BNS, 2023 (Sections 110, 117(2) of BNS, 2023 added vide rapat No.13 dated 11.01.2025, offence under Section 110 BNS was substituted with Section 109 BNS of 2023), at Police Station Sadar Abohar, District Fazilka.

Vide order dated 28.02.2025, while granting interim protection, the petitioner was directed to join investigation.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that in pursuance to the order passed by this Court, petitioner has joined the investigation and as such his interim bail may be made absolute.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI, Harwinder Singh, has stated that petitioner has joined the investigation and he is no more required for further investigation.

In view of the above, interim order dated 28.02.2025 is made absolute subject to compliance of conditions as envisaged under Section 482(2) of BNSS, 2023. Petition stands allowed.
