1. Prayer made in the present petition is for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to release the retiral benefits etc. with effect from 01.01.2016.
2. Learned counsel for the petitioners at the outset, on instructions from the petitioners, prays that at this stage, he will be satisfied if direction may be given to decide the representation dated 25.02.2025 (Annexure P-3), which is pending consideration before the respondents, in a time bound

manner. It is also submitted that if a direction is issued to the respondents to treat the instant writ petition as a representation and decide the same within a time bound manner.
